**NOTICE OF DISMISSAL**

An administrative hearing was scheduled and held on March 20, 2008. After the hearing this Administrative Law Judge received a copy of the Social Security Administration (SSA) final decision from the Claimant's representative for the Claimant's application dated May 26, 2006. This decision noted the Claimant had applied on August 27, 2003 and August 15, 2005 which she had been denied on September 30, 2005 and January 9, 2006 respectively. On May 26, 2006 the Claimant protectively and concurrently filed applications for disability. On February 4, 2009 SSA determined the Claimant's onset of disability to be June 2008. The Claimant failed to appeal the February 4, 2009 decision.

Based upon 42 CFR 435.541 SSA has made a final determination. Therefore a final determination has been made on this matter. Per PEM 260, p.2-3, the Claimant's case is hereby dismissed.

Administrative Hearings' jurisdiction ends when the Social Security Administration denies the grant of benefits and an appeal of this determination is not made within 60 days. Therefore, this Administrative Law Judge does not retain jurisdiction in this matter and the Claimant's request for a hearing is DISMISSED.
