ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9; MSA 16409 and MCL 40037; MSA 16.437 upon the Claimants request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was scheduled for November 24, 2010. The Claimant appeared and testified by telephone. [REDACTED], Recoupment Specialist and [REDACTED], Recoupment Specialist appeared on behalf of the Department.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the Department stipulated that the issues that led to the filing of a hearing request involving the over issuance and recoupment of Food Assistance and State Disability Cash Assistance would not be pursued at the hearing by the Department due to errors in the computation and documents previously prepared for the hearing and that it no longer wished to pursue the over issuance and recoupment of SDA and FAP benefits. Because the Department no longer wishes to pursue over issuance and recoupment of FAP and SDA benefits for the period 7/1/05 through 10/31/06 there is no further issue for this Administrative Law Judge to resolve. Accordingly the case is dismissed with Prejudice and the Department is not entitled to an over issuance of recoupment of FAP or SDA benefits.
