FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the competent, material and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

 July 12, 2006, claimant applied for MA. Claimant submitted medical records for department consideration. 2007-20326/jab

(2)December 29, 2006, the Medical Review Team denied claimant's application.

January 5, 2007, the department sent claimant written notice that the application (3)

was denied.

(4) April 24, 2007, the department received claimant's request for hearing. The

request for hearing is not timely.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Medical Assistance (MA) program is established by Title XIX of the Social Security

Act and is implemented by Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). The Department

of Human Services (DHS or department) administers the MA program pursuant to MCL 400.10,

et seq., and MCL 400.105. Department policies are found in the Program Administrative

Manual (PAM), the Program Eligibility Manual (PEM) and the Program Reference Manual

(PRM).

JOINT POLICY DEVELOPMENT

Medicaid, Adult Medical Program (AMP) also known as Adult Benefit Waiver (ABW), Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA/TMA-Plus), and Maternity Outpatient Medical Services (MOMS) policy has been developed jointly by the

Department of Community Health (DCH) and the Department of Human Services

(DHS).

In this case, the department issued notice of case action on January 5, 2008. Claimant

had 90 calendar days to present a hearing request. The hearing request was submitted on the

109th day after the date of the notice of case action. Finding of Fact 2-4; PAM 600. Accordingly,

the hearing request is not timely and the Administrative Law Judge does not have jurisdiction

over the matter at issue. Therefore, the matter must be dismissed.

DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the above findings of fact and conclusions

of law, decides that the hearing request is not timely.

Accordingly, the matter is HEREBY DISMISSED.
