DEBT COLLECTION HEARING ORDER OF DISMISSAL

A hearing in this matter was scheduled to be held on June 21, 2011. On the date and time set for hearing, Respondent failed to appear; the Department of Human Services (the Department) was represented by agency personnel. Just after convening the hearing, it was determined that the notice of hearing, hearing summary, and other documents mailed to Claimant's last known address [REDACTED] [REDACTED] were returned by the United States Postal Service as undeliverable. In accordance with Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM) 725, p 19, a debt collection hearing may not proceed and must be dismissed, where the respondent or his representative fails to appear and the notice of hearing is returned as undeliverable.

Furthermore, the Department presented evidence that the overissuance in dispute was paid in full on March 17, 2011.

Therefore, for either of the above reasons, the above-captioned matter is DISMISSED.
