ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon Department of Human Services (DHS) request for a debt establishment hearing filed on .

Respondent received State Disability Assistance (SDA) benefits until she was determined not to be disabled by department's Medical Review Team. Respondent requested a hearing on department's proposed closure of her SDA benefits and received such benefits until department's decision was upheld in an administrative hearing. Department then proceeded to collect respondent's ineligibly received SDA benefits through a debt collection hearing. However, respondent was then approved for SSI and SSA reimbursed the department for SDA benefits respondent received during the pendency of her SSI application. Therefore, ineligibly received SDA benefits no longer need to be collected from the respondent.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903 hearing request is **HEREBY DISMISSED**.
