

NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

An administrative hearing was scheduled on the above-mentioned date. The Claimant was awarded SSI with a disability onset date of November 20, 2007. The Claimant's request for benefits made on November 14, 2007 fits within this period. The Department is to activate coverage as allowed by policy based upon the SSI approval which includes three months of retro MA back to August 2007 as requested.

Administrative Hearings' jurisdiction ends when the Social Security Administration approves the grant of benefits. Therefore, this Administrative Law Judge does not retain jurisdiction in this matter and the Claimant's request for a hearing is DISMISSED.
