ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned by authority of MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon a DHS request for a hearing for debt establishment to pursue collection actions of allegedly over-issued benefits. [REDACTED] (Respondent) also requested a hearing disputing the recoupment of over-issued benefits.

Prior to the opening of a hearing record, DHS stated off-the-record that debt establishment need not be pursued as Respondent has fully repaid the allegedly over-issued benefits. Respondent appeared for the hearing but left prior to the commencement of the hearing. On behalf of Respondent, DHS submitted a Hearing Request Withdrawal signed by Respondent, not DHS, agreeing to dismiss the debt establishment based on the repayment of allegedly over-issued benefits.

Because DHS no longer wishes to pursue debt establishment and Respondent failed to proceed with the administrative hearing, the undersigned finds that both parties have agreed to forego their rights to administrative hearing as there are no issues within dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, the DHS and Respondent hearing requests are hereby DISMISSED, because Respondent no longer disputes an action by DHS and DHS has no need for debt establishment against Respondent.
