ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on July 11, 2008.

While the claimant and the county was telephoned for the hearing, no testimony was taken as it was found that this same issue had been addressed by this Administrative Law Judge in a previous hearing, which was held on February 3, 2009. The claimant was disputing her FIP benefits closure of July 8, 2008. This was the same issue adjudicated on February 3, 2009.

Therefore, it is not necessary for this Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because this issue has already been adjudicated. Claimant can always request reconsideration or a rehearing on the hearing decision from February 3, 2008, pursuant to MAC R 400.919.
