**DEBT COLLECTION HEARING ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The Department of Human Services (the Department) brought a collection action because Respondent allegedly received public assistance and/or food assistance benefits to which he was not entitled. According to the Department, Respondent received an overissuance of Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits in the amount of [REDACTED]. A hearing in this matter was scheduled to be held on July 21, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. On the date and time set for hearing, Respondent failed to appear. The Department was represented by agency personnel. Shortly after the hearing commenced, the Department indicated that Respondent has paid the [REDACTED] debt. The Department provided the undersigned with a copy of Bridges Activity Sheet and Claim Detail/Claim Information documents which confirmed that Respondent has paid in full and there is a \$0 outstanding balance on his collection account. Accordingly, the Department no longer believed it was necessary to continue with the hearing in this matter.

For this reason, the above-captioned matter is DISMISSED.
