ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a hearing was held March 12, 2009.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record it was determined that claimant's request for hearing had been resolved. Claimant's application for Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits was initially denied due to excess income. After several back and forths with the department, On January 13, 2009, the department determined that claimant was eligible for benefits, reinstated the application, determined claimant's benefit amount, opened the case, and supplemented claimant for benefits back to the date of application. Claimant has some concerns with department actions that have occurred since then, but those issues are not within the jurisdiction of this hearing. Claimant was informed that she can have those concerns addressed by requesting a hearing about those specific departmental actions.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is not aggrieved by a department action.
