ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on January 22, 2009. After due notice, a hearing was held October 7, 2009.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the department agreed to re-process the claimant's original Medical Assistance (MA) application (from 2008) to determine eligibility for MA benefits. The claimant had been mailed a notice of denial, but the department had opened a MA case for the claimant, so it is unclear if the department took proper action on the original application. Thus, the department agreed to re-process the original MA application. If the claimant is eligible for MA coverage, the coverage will be retroactive to the original date of application. If the claimant is not eligible due to income or assets, the claimant will be given a new notice of case action informing her of the reason for denial. The claimant indicated this addressed her hearing issue and she had no further issues.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action.
