ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on May 11, 2009. After due notice, a hearing was held June 17, 2009.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the department agreed to re-process the claimant's application back to the date of application, February 17, 2009. The claimant's application for MA and FAP had been denied for a failure to provide requested verifications. However, as the department representative looked through the file, the requested verifications were found. Thus, the department representative testified that he would re-process the application back to the date it was completed and turn in. The claimant indicated that would resolve her hearing issue.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute.

Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action.
