ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on June 25, 2009. After due notice, a hearing was held on July 29, 2009.

Claimant was scheduled for a hearing on a previous disability Medicaid (MA) and State Disability Assistance (SDA) due to a hearing request he filed in the past on such denial, with Register Number 2009-25916. Prior to the start of the hearing it was discovered that the claimant had filed a hearing request on a subsequent disability MA and SDA denial of June 18, 2009, due to his failure to provide requested medical determination. As the issue is the same, the Administrative Law Judge explained to the claimant that his MA and SDA disability eligibility will be addressed on his previous hearing request. Claimant agreed that this hearing request should therefore be dismissed as it is duplicative. Hearing Register Number 2009-25916 was held, claimant's medical information admitted into evidence, and record extended so additional medical information can be obtained by the department.

Therefore, pursuant to MAC R 400.906, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because the claimant agreed on the record to withdraw his hearing request.
