ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on July 15, 2009. After due notice, a hearing was held August 25, 2009.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the department representative testified that she had received a request for a second Semi-Annual Contact Form (DHS-1046) from the claimant prior to the end of the recertification period. However, before the DHS-1046 could be sent to the claimant, BRIDGES closed the claimant's FAP benefits. The department representative testified that the claimant's case should be re-opened and re-instated back to the date of closure, July 1, 2009 and the claimant should be issued any retroactive benefits she would be entitled to. The claimant agreed with the actions suggested by the department.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute.

Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action.
