HEARING DECISION

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on January 12, 2010.

ISSUE

Is Medicaid application still pending completion at the local DHS?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the competent, material and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

- (1) Negative case action: Medicaid application on February 27, 2007 retroactive to November 2006 is still pending completion before the local DHS.
- (2) The DHS acknowledged its responsibility to immediately complete the application process.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Medical Assistance (MA) program is established by Title XIX of the Social Security Act and is implemented by Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). The Department of Human Services (DHS or department) administers the MA program pursuant to MCL 400.10, *et seq.*, and MCL 400.105. Department policies are found in the Program Administrative Manual (PAM), the Program Eligibility Manual (PEM) and the Program Reference Manual (PRM).

Facts above are undisputed.

Both parties agreed that there is still a pending Medicaid application at the local DHS for completion.

DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the above findings of fact and conclusions of law, decides that there is still a pending Medicaid application before the DHS.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the local DHS promptly complete the Medicaid application process within 10 work days.
