ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on February 19, 2009. After due notice, a hearing was to be held on October 21, 2009.

This hearing was scheduled as a telephone hearing to commence at 2:30 PM. Claimant called SOAHR at approximately 3:15 PM to state he forgot about the hearing, and to ask that the hearing be held by a three way telephone connection so he could participate from his home. Claimant gave his telephone number as (231) 409-2156. The Administrative Law Judge called the number given by the claimant at 3:24 PM after having to contact local DHS office to let them know claimant wants to participate from his home. There was no response at the number given by the claimant and a message was left for him to call right away regarding the hearing. Claimant did not call and is therefore considered to have failed to appear for the hearing.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute.

Pursuant to MAC R 400.906, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because the claimant failed to appear for the scheduled hearing.
