ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on . After due notice, a hearing was held . Claimant was represented by [REDACTED] .

Claimant had previously been approved for Medicaid (MA) and State Disability Assistance (SDA) by the department. A medical review was due in February, 2009, at which time department found that the claimant no longer met the disability criteria for MA and SDA. Department took action to terminate claimant's MA and SDA benefits effective March 17, 2009. Claimant requested a hearing prior to the closure date, and department continued her MA and SDA benefits pending the outcome of the hearing. Claimant subsequently submitted additional medical information, but State Hearing Review Team again found that the claimant no longer met the disability criteria for MA and SDA.

As the claimant had applied for SSI, a computer inquiry from SSA records was performed by staff of SOAHR on March 26, 2010. The SSA report, SOLQ, indicated that the claimant is deceased. Subsequent information received from the department is that the claimant indeed died on October 14, 2009. Claimant received MA and SDA benefits to the date of her death.

Therefore, there is no issue remaining for the Administrative Law Judge to decide. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED. SO ORDERED.


