ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on May 8, 2009.

After due notice, a hearing was held on July 2, 2009. Claimant personally appeared along with his attorney [REDACTED], [REDACTED]

Claimant's hearing issue is department's budgeting of RSDI income on his Food Assistance Program (FAP) case that resulted in reduction of FAP benefits in May, 2009. Department's representative states that the RSDI budgeted for the claimant is income received by his father (who has the same name and therefore the confusion with SSA records), and not by him. Department has corrected claimant's FAP case to remove RSDI income. Claimant and his attorney agree that the hearing issue has therefore been resolved.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute.

Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action.
