ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT AND DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a hearing was held July 16, 2009.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record the parties agreed that Claimant's Family Independence Program (FIP) case should be reinstated and that Claimant should withdraw her request for hearing. It was discovered at the hearing that Claimant was participating in a Michigan Rehabilitative Services (MRS) program which will probably satisfy at least a large portion of her participation requirements for the Michigan Works Agency/Jobs, Education and Training Program (JET). The specifics of the agreed resolution are memorialized on the Hearing Request Withdrawal and signed by all parties.

Therefore, it is ORDERED that Claimant's Family Independence Program (FIP) case be reinstated and pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action.
