HEARING DECISION

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9; MSA 16.409 and MCL 400.37; MSA 16.437 upon claimant's May 28, 2009 request for a hearing to protest the department's denial of Medical Assistance and retroactive Medical Assistance. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held, Wednesday, September 2, 2009. The claimant was not present, but was represented by his authorized representative, [REDACTED].

ISSUE

Whether claimant meets the disability criteria for Medical Assistance (MA-P) and retroactive Medical Assistance?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds a material fact:

1. On January 12, 2009, the claimant applied for MA-P with retroactive MA-P to December 2008.
2. Subsequent to the hearing, the Social Security Administration determined that the claimant met the disability criteria for the RSDI program effective [REDACTED].
