ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a hearing was held August 11, 2009.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record it was determined that Claimant submitted a hearing request on June 16, 2009, concerning her non-cooperation status with the Office of Child Support determined on 12/29/06. Claimant had applied for Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits on 12/1/08. Claimant's two children were determined eligible for Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits but Claimant was not included in the benefit group due to her non-cooperation status. Claimant received notice of the most recent Food Assistance Program (FAP) determination on December 15, 2008. Program Administrative Manual (PAM) 600 clearly states that a request for hearing must be submitted within 90 days of written notice of case action. There is no jurisdiction to hear Claimant's concern.

Therefore, pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED.
