ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on August 26, 2009. After due notice, a hearing was held October 6, 2009.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, it was determined that the claimant was trying to appeal a previous decision by an Administrative Law Judge from an August 11, 2009 hearing. The claimant indicated that he wanted to appeal the decision of that Administrative Law Judge and that this was not a new or separate appeal. Thus, this appeal was scheduled incorrectly and should have been scheduled as a rehearing request.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. The hearing request was turned in timely for a rehearing request and was incorrectly scheduled.

Thus, this Administrative Law Judge does not have jurisdiction over this issue and will dismiss this hearing request to be referred to rehearings and rescheduled.
