

**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on April 20, 2010, in order to protest the denial of claimant's December 23, 2009, application for Medical Assistance and retroactive Medical Assistance. Claimant appeared and testified. Claimant was represented by [REDACTED].

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, claimant's authorized representative withdrew the request for hearing because "DHS has activated coverage for the date requested."
