ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Claimant filed this hearing request asking for retro Medicaid (MA) coverage for the month of June, 2008. Department prepared a Hearing Summary stating that the claimant's MA case was "put into negative action on 2-12-2009 for failure to return redetermination and verification", and that the MA case closed on February 24, 2009. After discussion with departmental staff, it was determined that the claimant indeed had an active MA case and that the department did not grant him MA coverage for June, 2008 by mistake. This mistake was due to the claimant having an MA deductible of around \$700 for June, 2008. However, hearing testimony indicates that the claimant had a \$60,000 plus hospital bill for this month. Verification

of this hospital stay was provided to the department as it is in the hearing packet, and the claimant very obviously met his deductible and should have been granted MA coverage on the day he met it in June, 2008. Department agreed on the record to initiate the process (by sending appropriate request to department's main office) to add MA coverage for the claimant for June, 2008. Claimant's representative states that she is satisfied with this issue resolution.

Claimant's hearing request is hereby DISMISSED in accordance with MAC 400.906. SO ORDERED.
