ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37 upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on August 10, 2010 and August 31, 2010. After due notice, a hearing was held January 13, 2011.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the department agreed to reprocess the claimant's MA and retroactive MA application dated February 11, 2010. While the claimant had previously had a life insurance policy that made her excess assets for MA coverage, the claimant testified that she had cashed in that policy on November 4, 2009 and used the proceeds to pay bills. The department indicated that no Verification Checklist (DHS-3503) had been sent to the claimant and her representative to have the assets verified. Therefore, the department agreed to request verification of the assets to determine the claimant's eligibility for the MA and retroactive MA months. The claimant and her representative testified that this resolved the hearing issue.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action.
