ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a hearing was held January 14, 2010.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record it was determined that on September 23, 2009: Claimant's Family Independence Program (FIP) case had been closed on her request but she had reapplied and lost no period of eligibility; Claimant's Medical Assistance (MA) case had been closed in error and reinstated but Claimant lost no period of eligibility; and Claimant's Food Assistance Program (FAP) case had closed on her request but she had gone back on her mother's case and Claimant lost no period of eligibility. Claimant stated her primary concern was her claim that she had not received all the Family Independence Program (FIP) and Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits she was due from her eligibility prior to closure of the case.

Therefore, this request for hearing has no issues in dispute for this Administrative Law Judge to decide.

Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED.
