**ORDER AWARDING CDC PROCESSING**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9; MCL 400.37; MAC R 400.919 upon claimant's request for a hearing.

After due notice, an in-person pre-hearing conference was held on November 18, 2010, at the Ingham County DHS offices in Lansing. Claimant personally appeared.

The department was represented by Deb Ordiway (FIM).

At the pre-hearing conference, the parties stipulated as follows:

- (1) The Ingham DHS office will reprocess claimant's CDC application (using the eligibility evidence already in the file) to determine claimant's CDC eligibility for the period September 28, 2008 through February 28, 2009.
- (2) The Ingham DHS office will issue a written eligibility decision stating the amount of claimant's CDC benefits on or before December 18, 2010.
- (3) The parties will conform to the provisions of the DHS-18A, dated November 18, 2010 in all respects.
- (4) The DHS 18A is hereby incorporated by reference.
