ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on August 11, 2009. After due notice, a hearing was held April 13, 2010.

Claimant applied for State Disability Assistance (SDA) on June 17, 2009 on the basis of caring for her disabled mother. Department denied claimant's application on August 3, 2009, an action that was determined to be in error when claimant's case was reviewed on September 17, 2009. Department corrected the error by re-processing claimant's June 17, 2009 SDA application and granting her SDA benefits effective July 16, 2009, in accordance with departmental policy.

Department's action was explained in the hearing. Claimant states she now understands what was done on her case and has no further concerns.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action.
