SUMMARY DISPOSITION

The claimant applied for Medicaid (MA-P) and State Disability Assistance (SDA) on July 8, 2009.

On January 27, 2010 the Social Security Administration found the claimant eligible for SSI with the disability onset date of May 30, 2009. This determination is binding upon the department.

Therefore, the claimant has been determined medically eligible for MA-P and SDA.

The claimant meets the definition of medically disabled for MA-P and SDA. The department is hereby ORDERED to determine if the claimant is otherwise eligible. If otherwise eligible, the department shall determine eligibility effective dates using the July 8, 2009 application date.

If the department determines that the claimant is not otherwise eligible, legally sufficient notice must be provided to the claimant.
