**DISMISSAL ORDER**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon the Claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was conducted from Detroit, Michigan on Tuesday, September 7, 2010. The Claimant did not appear however her authorized hearing representative, [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] appeared and testified. Mary Strand appeared on behalf of the Department.

The regulations governing hearings and appeals for applicants and recipients of public assistance in Michigan are found in the Michigan Administrative Code ("MAC") at MAC R 400.901-.951. MAC R 400.903 provides in relevant part:

An opportunity for a hearing shall be granted to an application who requests a hearing because a claim for assistance is denied or is not acted upon with reasonable promptness, and to any recipient who is aggrieved by an agency action resulting in suspension, reduction, discontinuance, or termination of assistance. MAC R 400.903; BAM 600

In this case, the Claimant seeks a currently dated (today's date) denied Eligibility Notice. The Claimant/Representative is not contesting the denial of benefits or that the application was not acted upon with reasonable promptness. Further, the Claimant/Representative has not been aggrieved by an agency action which resulted in the suspension, discontinuance, or termination of public assistance. Accordingly, the undersigned lacks jurisdiction and the request for hearing is dismissed pursuant to MAC R 400.903(1) and Bridges Administrative Manual 600.
