AMENDED HEARING DECISION

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon the Claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was conducted on February 3, 2010 and an Order was issued on March 9, 2010. The Claimant appeared and testified along with his wife, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED], ES appeared on behalf of the Department. The following Order incorporates the Issue, Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law from the 3/9/10 Order but Amends the Decision and Order as follows:


AMENDED DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the 3/9/10 findings of fact and conclusions of law, finds that the Department improperly denied the Claimant FAP benefits.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED:

1. The Department's FAP denial of 10/10/09 is REVERSED.

2. The Department shall reopen and reprocess Claimant's FAP case from the date of application, 6/10/09, prospecting income based on the Claimant's 2009 tax returns.
3. The Department shall supplement Claimant with any lost benefits he was otherwise entitled to receive.
