ORDER FOR FIP-MA REPROCESSING

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9; MCL 400.37; MAC R 400.919 upon claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on July 13, 2010 at the Luce DHS office in Newberry. Claimant personally appeared and testified. Claimant was represented by [REDACTED].

After a thorough review of the sworn testimony presented at the hearing, the undersigned orders the local office as follows:

- (1) The local office shall reprocess claimant's November 25, 2008 FIP-related MA/retro application using the information provided on the DHS-1171, dated November 25, 2008; and
- (2) The local office shall provide to claimant a written eligibility determination which expressly states claimant's eligibility for the MA program in question, with appropriate citations to BEM and BAM.


