ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a hearing was held on February 11, 2010.

Prior to the close of the hearing record, the Administrative Law Judge was advised by the Department representative that claimant would be given a DHS-754 and sent back to JET classes with no sanction. One penalty would be applied to claimant's FIP case. Claimant would be supplemented a missed FIP allocation dating from October 1, 2009 through October 15, 2009. Claimant accepted this offer.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that is in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY

DISMISSED, because the claimant is no longer aggrieved by the Department action.
