ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a hearing was held on December 7, 2009.

Prior to the close of the hearing record, the Administrative Law Judge was advised by the Department representative that claimant's FAP budget was computed incorrectly. The Department agreed to recalculate claimant's budget retroactively to the date of the initial DHS-1171 filing, February 23, 2009. Should claimant's FAP budget increase as a result of these new calculations, the Department will supplement claimant's benefits retroactively to February 23, 2009. Should the claimant be aggrieved by this new calculation, claimant reserves the right to request a hearing on this new calculation.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that is in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY

DISMISSED, because the claimant is no longer aggrieved by the Department's action.
