## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9, MCL 400.37, and upon Claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on April 4, 2011. Claim ant appeared and testified. The Department of Human Services (Department or DHS) was represented by

BAM 600, p. 4, instructs:

The client or authorized hearing representative has 90 calendar days from the date of the written notice of case action to request a hearing. The request must be received anywhere in DHS within the 90 days.

In the present case, Claimant filed a Request for Hearing on March 8, 2011, for negative action taken on May 3, 2010, in wh ich the Department issued Claimant a Notice of Overissuance r egarding Claimant's Food Assi stance Program (FAP) cas e. Claimant states that she re ceived the Notice of May 3, 2010, and contacted the Department. Claimant stated that the Department worker explained that the Overissuance was Agency error, and Claimant did not pursue the matter further at that time. Claimant says she received another not lice a couple of months later, and she does not deny that she received a lesser amount in food assist ance benefits following the May 3, 2010 notice. Ho wever, it was not until Cla imant's FAP c ase closed and Claimant received a Notice of Balance Due, dated Februar y 1, 2011, that Claimant objected to the Overissuance determination that was initially made on May 3, 2010.

Since Claimant's request for hearing of March 8, 2010, was past 90 days from the date of negative action of May 3, 2010, it is O RDERED that this matter is DISMISSED, pursuant to BAM 600.
