ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of Michigan Compiled Laws 400.9 and 400.37 and Claimant [REDACTED] request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on June 1, 2011. The Claimant did not appear. [REDACTED] Claimant's Authorized Representative, appeared and testified on behalf of the Claimant. [REDACTED] Eligibility Specialist, and [REDACTED], Family Independence Manager, appeared and testified on behalf of the Department of Human Services (DHS).

Prior to the close of the hearing, the Claimant testified that she subsequently reapplied and did receive SER assistance from DHS. Claimant testified she was no longer aggrieved by the Department's action with regard to her request for State Emergency Relief. Claimant requested that the Administrative Law Judge dismiss her Hearing Request. Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute.

Pursuant to Michigan Administrative Code Rules 400.903 and 400.906, Claimant's hearing request is hereby DISMISSED, as Claimant is no longer aggrieved by a DHS action.
