

HEARING DECISION

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9; MSA 16.409 and MCL 400.37; M SA 16.437 upon the Claimant's r equest for a hearing. After due notice a telephone hearing was held on May 19, 2011. The Claima nt personally appeared and testified.

ISSUE

Did the Department of Hum an Services (Department) properly close the Claimant's Medical Assistance (MA)?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

- 1. On January 3, 2011, the Claimant applied for MA.
- 2. On January 11, 2011, the Department sent the Claimant a verification checklist, due January 21 2011.
- 3. On March 9, 2011, the Department denied the Cla imant's MA application for failure to provide verifications.
- 4. On March 17, 2011, the Claimant filed a request for a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The MA program is established by T itle XIX of the Socia I Security Act and is implemented by T itle 42 of t he Code of F ederal Regulations (CFR). The Department

(formerly known as the Fa mily Independence Agenc y) admin isters the MA program pursuant to MCL 400.10 *et seq*. and MCL 400.105. Departmen t policies are found in the Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), the Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM) and the Program Reference Manual (PRM).

In the instant case, the Department requested employment and income information.

The Claim ant provided the Department wit h a profit and loss statement (Schedule C) and other documentation. The Department found this documentation inadequate.

Obtaining Verification

All Programs

Tell the client what verification is required, how to obtain it, and the due date (see "Timeliness Standards" in this item). Use the DHS-3503, Verification Checklist, or for MA redeterminations, the DHS-1175, MA Determination Notice, to request verification...

The client must obtain required veri fication, but you must assist if they need and request help.

If neither the client nor you c an obtain verification despite a reasonable effort, use the best available information. If **no** evidence is available, use your best judgment. BAM 130, p. 2-3.

Here, the requested verification was prov ided the Department but it found the verification inadequate to resolve the request for verification.

The Department failed to follow the abov e pol icy in not using "the best availab le information." Therefore, the Department was in error in denying the Claimant's MA.

DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the above findings of fact and conclusions of law, REVE RSES A ND ORDE RS the De partment to reregister the Claimant's MA application back to January 3, 2011, and replace any lost benefits, if appropriate.

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
