ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of Michigan Compiled Laws Sections 400.9 and 400.37, and Claimant [REDACTED] request for a hearing. After due notice was given, a telephone hearing was held on June 27, 2011. The Claimant appeared and testified at the hearing. [REDACTED] Eligibility Specialist, appeared and testified on behalf of the Department of Human Services (DHS).

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the Claimant testified that she was in full receipt of the Food Assistance Program and State Emergency Relief benefits to which she was entitled, and she did not wish to apply for State Disability Assistance at this time. She testified she was satisfied with the status of her benefits and requested that the Administrative Law Judge dismiss her Hearing Request.

Therefore, because Claimant is no longer aggrieved by a Department Action, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matters that were in dispute. Pursuant to Michigan Administrative Code Rules 400.903 and 400.906, and at Claimant's request, the Claimant's Hearing Request is HEREBY DISMISSED.
