ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon Claimant's request for a hearing filed on March 24, 2011. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held July 20, 2011. The law, MCL 24.278(2) provides that a disposition may be made of a contested case hearing by stipulation or agreed settlement. In this case, Claimant requested a hearing protesting that her application for Medical Assistance (MA) benefits submitted on May 26, 2010 was never processed.

Prior to the close of the hearing, the department agreed to process Claimant's application signed April 30, 2010, that was submitted with Claimant's hearing request, back to the date of application, May 26, 2010, retro to April 2010.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, Claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because Claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action.
