**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37 upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on November 18, 2010. After due notice, a hearing was held January 27, 2011.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the department agreed to reinstate the claimant's Medical Assistance (MA) back to the date of closure. The claimant indicated that he had medical bills that could meet his deductible that had not been submitted to the department. Thus, the claimant agreed to submit the medical bills to allow the department to determine if his deductible had been met. The claimant testified that he did not have any issues with the Food Assistance Program (FAP) and that this resolved his hearing request.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action.
