ORDER APPROVING BENEFITS FOR MA-P

Upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on December 14, 2010. Claimant personally appeared at the hearing with her representative, [REDACTED], Inc.


The Department was represented by [REDACTED]).

At a pre-hearing conference, claimant submitted a Social Security letter dated February 8, 2011, awarding claimant SSI benefits with a disability onset date of May 1, 2010. At the pre-hearing, the department submitted an SOLQ report (March 16, 2009), showing that claimant has been an active MA-P recipient since May 1, 2010.

Based on the February 8, 2011, SSA approval, DHS opened claimant's MA-P case effective May 1, 2010. On July 6, 2010, claimant submitted a MA-P application requesting Retro-MA for April 2010.

Based on the SSI approval and the DHS Retro application, claimant is eligible for MA-P Retro coverage, effective April 1, 2010.
