**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned by authority of MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon Claimant's request for a hearing filed on 1/6/11 disputing a termination of Medical Assistance (MA) benefits. After due notice, a hearing record was opened. Claimant appeared and testified; Wanda Merrick appeared and testified on behalf of Claimant. On behalf of Department of Human Services (DHS), [REDACTED] Manager, appeared and testified.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, DHS testified that Claimant's MA benefits were terminated in error and that MA benefits were reopened for Claimant. It was also established that Claimant suffered no lapse in MA coverage. Claimant conceded that there is no longer a dispute concerning MA benefits. As Claimant no longer disputes an action by Department of Human Services (DHS), it is not necessary for the undersigned to decide the matter that was previously in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, Claimant's hearing request is hereby DISMISSED.
