**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon Claimant's request for a hearing filed on [REDACTED]. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held [REDACTED].

Claimant reported new income and when the department computed her continued eligibility, Claimant's FIP benefits decreased to \$10.00 a month, at which time Claimant appealed. Prior to the closure of the hearing record, Claimant testified that she now understood the department's actions. At this time, Claimant was satisfied with the department's actions and did not want to continue with the hearing.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, Claimant's hearing request is **HEREBY DISMISSED**, because Claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action as it pertains to her FIP benefits.
