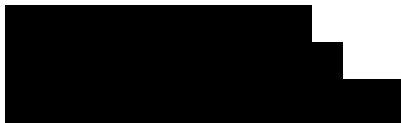

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a hearing was held on June 23, 2011 in Detroit, Michigan. The witnesses participated by telephone from the Department of Human Services Office in Wayne County, Michigan, District 18.

Prior to the opening of the hearing record, the Administrative Law Judge was made aware that there was no longer a dispute to be settled. Claimant's initial hearing request was based upon a denial of claimant's MA application due to lack of disability. Claimant admitted, and the Department showed, that claimant's MA benefits had been instated.

Therefore, the Administrative Law Judge is unable to decide the matter that is in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because the Administrative Law Judge has determined that there is no longer an issue to be decided.

reconsideration on the Department's motion where the final decision cannot be implemented within 90 days of the filing of the original request.

The Claimant may appeal the Decision and Order to Circuit Court within 30 days of the mailing of the Decision and Order or, if a timely request for rehearing was made, within 30 days of the receipt date of the rehearing decision.
