**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9; and MCL 400.37 upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on [REDACTED]. After due notice, a hearing was held [REDACTED].

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the claimant testified that she had received a notice from the DHS Medicaid Processing Unit that indicated she had been approved for interim Medicaid as a result of a lawsuit settlement. The department representative faxed the notice to the undersigned. This notice does indicate that the claimant has been approved for interim [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] and continuing. The department worker also checked the claimant's case and found she was currently active for [REDACTED]. The claimant testified that this resolved her hearing issue.
