**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of Michigan Compiled Laws Sections 400.9 and 400.37 and Claimant [REDACTED] request for a hearing. After due notice was given, a telephone hearing was held on May 11, 2011. Claimant appeared and testified at the hearing. [REDACTED] appeared and testified on behalf of the Department of Human Services (DHS).

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, Claimant testified that she was in full receipt of the Food Assistance Program (FAP) and Medical Assistance (MA or Medicaid) benefits to which she was entitled. She further testified that she wished only to submit a complaint to the appropriate person or office regarding the quality of the service she received at DHS.

Pursuant to Michigan Administrative Code Rules 400.903 and 400.906, the Administrative Law Judge has no authority to hear complaints regarding the quality of service provided by DHS to its clients. Accordingly, as I have no jurisdiction over this matter, Claimant's Hearing Request is DISMISSED.
