ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of Michigan Compiled Laws 400.9 and 400.37 and Claimant [REDACTED] request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephonic hearing was held on June 22, 2011. The Claimant appeared and testified. [REDACTED] Eligibility Specialist, appeared and testified on behalf of the Department of Human Services (DHS).

Prior to the closure of the hearing, the Claimant testified that she was no longer aggrieved by the Department's action with regard to her request for State Emergency Relief for assistance with her property taxes.
