**CONSENT ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 following Claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on September 15, 2011, in Lansing, Michigan. Claimant personally appeared and provided testimony. Participants on behalf of the Department of Human Services (Department) include [REDACTED].

The Michigan Administrative Code R 400.903(1) provides as follows:

An opportunity for a hearing shall be granted to an applicant who requests a hearing because his claim for assistance is denied or is not acted upon with reasonable promptness, and to any recipient who is aggrieved by an agency action resulting in suspension, reduction, discontinuance, or termination of assistance.

In this case, on June 16, 2011, the Department  closed Claimant's case for benefits for:  Medical Assistance (MA).

Claimant requested a hearing to dispute the Department's action pertaining to the MA program. After commencement of the hearing, the Department representative acknowledged that the Department erred and agreed to issue Claimant retroactive MA benefits for July, 2011. Claimant testified that she now understood and accepted the actions taken by the Department. Claimant also testified that she did not wish to proceed with a hearing. The Department agreed to the dismissal of Claimant's hearing request. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906(1), Claimant's hearing request is hereby DISMISSED.

Based on the above discussion, it is ORDERED that this matter is DISMISSED pursuant to MAC R 400.906(1).
