**CONSENT ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 following the Claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was conducted from Detroit, Michigan on Thursday, November 17, 2011. The Claimant did not appear; however, his Authorized Hearing Representative, [REDACTED] appeared on his behalf. [REDACTED] appeared on behalf of the Department of Human Services ("Department").

The Michigan Administrative Code Rule ("MAC R") 400.903(1) provides as follows:

An opportunity for a hearing shall be granted to an applicant who requests a hearing because his claim for assistance is denied or is not acted upon with reasonable promptness, and to any recipient who is aggrieved by an agency action resulting in suspension, reduction, discontinuance, or termination of assistance.

In addition, the law provides that disposition may be made of a contested case by stipulation or agreed settlement. MCL 24.278(2)

In this case, the Claimant requested a hearing to dispute the Department's action. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, Claimant testified that she now understands and accepts the actions taken by the Department. The Claimant also testified that she did not wish to proceed with a hearing. The Department agreed to the

dismissal of Claimant's hearing request. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906(1) and MCL 24.278(2), the Claimant's hearing request is hereby DISMISSED.

Based on the above discussion, it is ORDERED that this matter is DISMISSED.
