**HEARING DECISION**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9; MSA 16.409 and MCL 400.37; MSA 16.437 upon claimant's December 6, 2010 request for a hearing to protest the department's denial of Medical Assistance and State Disability Assistance (SDA). After due notice, a telephone hearing was held Tuesday, April 12, 2011. The claimant personally appeared and testified on his own behalf with his attorney, ██████████, P# 73510.

**ISSUE**

Whether claimant meets the disability criteria for Medical Assistance (MA-P) and retroactive Medical Assistance?

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds a material fact:

1. On October 14, 2010, the claimant applied for MA-P and SDA.
2. On January 13, 2012, an Administrative Law Judge found that the claimant was disabled as of June 22, 2011 with retroactive MA-P to March 2011.
3. This Administrative Law Judge finds that based on the objective medical evidence on the record that the claimant meets the criteria for disability retroactive to October 2010 to February 2011 and SDA based on his October 14, 2010 application.



**NOTICE:** Administrative Hearings may order a rehearing or reconsideration on either its own motion or at the request of a party within 30 days of the mailing date of this Decision and Order. Administrative Hearings will not order a rehearing or reconsideration on the Department's motion where the final decision cannot be implemented within 90 days of the filing of the original request.

The Claimant may appeal the Decision and Order to Circuit Court within 30 days of the mailing of the Decision and Order or, if a timely request for rehearing was made, within 30 days of the receipt date of the rehearing decision.
